



How to Become a State Representative

Looking for A Way to Serve DeMolay Now That You Are a PMC? Become A State Representative!

Basic Requirements:

- Past or Current Master Councilor
- At least 16 years of age (*or by Executive Officer Dispensation*)
- Parental Permission and Advisory Council Permission
- Own A Blue Blazer and Grey Dress Pants

Description of the Program:

The State Representative Program is a new position for members of Massachusetts DeMolay. It is a program for Past Master Councilors, however an existing Master Councilor can apply. As a State Representative you will assist the State Suite with the execution of the state program at specific events and even be in charge of planning an event. You may also be asked to help fill in for state installations or in state degrees if a State Officer is unavailable. You will meet with the State Suite on a semi-regular basis so that you may convey information back to your home chapter.

Becoming a State Representative is not a contract or guarantee that you will become one of the "traditional" state officers, however, it will give you a chance to see how much dedication and effort it takes to be a member of the State Suite. It will help you decide if that is something you may want to do in the future. The program has an open enrollment. Any qualified member can apply at anytime during the DeMolay year. The term of service will end at Conclave and you would have to re-apply if you wish to continue as a State Representative.
